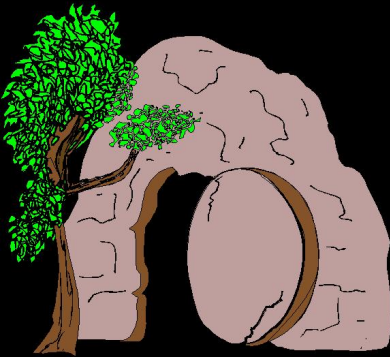


## WHERE DO I STAND WITH GOD? Lesson 10: Jesus Rises from the Dead



### Definitions

**disciple** - a person who has decided to follow, learn, and practice the teachings of another  
**“Son of Man”** – a phrase that Jesus used to refer to Himself

**1 Thessalonians 4:13-18** (Note: In this passage, Paul talks about those who are asleep, meaning those who have died.)

What sounds will we hear when Jesus comes back? (vs. 16) \_\_\_\_\_

What will happen to “the dead in Christ” at that time? (vs. 16) \_\_\_\_\_

Who will we go to meet in the air? \_\_\_\_\_

How long will we get to be with Jesus afterwards? \_\_\_\_\_

**Matthew 25:31-46** Who will be with Jesus when He returns? (vs. 31) \_\_\_\_\_

What will those on Jesus' right hand inherit? (vs. 34) \_\_\_\_\_

What were some of the good things that these people did for Jesus? (vss. 35-36) \_\_\_\_\_

When we do things, good or bad, for even the most seemingly insignificant follower of Jesus, who are we really doing these things to? (vss. 40 and 45) \_\_\_\_\_

To where was Jesus sending those on His left hand? (vss. 41) \_\_\_\_\_

Why was Jesus sending them there? (vss. 42-43) \_\_\_\_\_

**2 Peter 3** In the last days, what will some scoffers be saying? (vs. 4, a *scoffer* is someone who makes fun of something else)

In the days of Noah, God flooded the entire earth because everyone on it was wicked but Noah. Instead of using water, what will God use to destroy the earth when Jesus comes back? (vss. 5-7 and 10) \_\_\_\_\_

Why hasn't God sent Jesus back yet? What is He waiting for? (vs. 9) \_\_\_\_\_

When God destroys this earth and these "heavens" (*in other words, the sky and the universe*), with what will they be replaced? (vs. 13) \_\_\_\_\_

**Revelation 21:1-8** (*Note: In this passage, John, an apostle of Jesus, is shown what the new earth and heaven will be like.*)

What will life be like on this new earth? \_\_\_\_\_

In the next lesson, we will look at how we can be saved, how we can be forgiven of all our sins thanks to the love and grace of God and Jesus so that when Jesus comes back, we will get to be with Them forever.
