

WHERE DO I STAND WITH GOD? *Lesson 5: Jesus' Miracles*



Definitions: **blaspheme** – to speak of God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, etc., in an insulting way
demons / unclean spirits – evil spirits who work for the devil; what angels are to God, demons are to Satan
disciple – a person who has decided to follow, learn, and practice the teachings of another
leprosy – a very bad skin disease; leprosy can lead to paralysis, gangrene, and deformation
miracle – an event which can not possibly happen without the help and blessing of God
Pharisees – a group of Jews in Jesus' day that thought they strictly followed Moses' law but were instead following their own traditions and beliefs
Sabbath - the Jewish name for Saturday. It was to be a day of rest according to Moses' law.
Scribes / Teachers of the Law – a group of educated men in ancient Israel who studied the Old Testament; they served as copyists, editors, and teachers
Synagogue – a place where Jews came together for worship or religious study
