Definitions

Abraham (also called **Abram**) - A very important person in the Old Testament. He trusted God deeply and God richly blessed Abraham for that. Stories about Abraham are found in Genesis 11:27 - 25:11.

Hades (also called **Sheol**, sometimes translated as “**hell**”) - The place where the dead go to await judgment. Based on Numbers 16, it is somewhere under the surface of the earth. It has two parts - a place of rest and a place of torment.

revile - to use abusive language against a person

“**Woe to...**” - To pronounce that bad things will happen to someone; to curse someone.
